If you're an individual or community organisation undertaking a project for the benefit of the Redlands community, you may be eligible for funding under Redland City Council's Grants and Sponsorship Program.



Grants and sponsorship are offered across arts and cultural heritage, environment, community development, enterprise development, and sport and recreation.

All applicants must submit a grant or sponsorship application, which outlines how the project meets specific funding requirements set out in the program guidelines.



Funding for most grants is only available during specified periods so it is essential you plan your application in advance. All applications for sponsorship must be received at least three months prior to your project launch or event.

Our new and improved grants and sponsorship programs are aimed at maximising the benefits to the community and ensuring the fair distribution of resources in our city.
