Local Law Policy No. 7 (CAMPING GROUNDS)

PART 1 – PRELIMINARY

Citation

1. This local law policy may be cited as the Redland Shire Council Local Law Policy No. 7 (Camping Grounds).

Objects

2. The objects of this local law policy are to provide detailed information called upon by Local Law No. 7 (Camping Grounds) to –
 - 1) regulate the administration system for applications and term of permits.

PART 2 – COMMERCIAL CAMPING GROUNDS

Application for permit (Local Law No.7, s5)

3. For the purposes of section 5 of the local law, information and material to accompany an application for a permit is the permit fee as determined by Council by resolution.

Term of permit (Local Law No.7, s7)

4. For the purposes of section 7 of the local law, each camping ground permit will expire on 30 June of each year.

Conditions of permit (Local Law No.17, s8(4))

5. The conditions that must be imposed on a permit are –
 - 1) an application for renewal of permit is to be forwarded to Council not less than thirty (30) days prior to the expiration of the permit.
