Did you Know?

Council car parks

Redland City Council has a fleet of vehicles that need to be parked close to the Council buildings. These areas are in Doig Street and at the rear of the library building. They are marked with yellow paint, have 'Council Vehicle Only' signage and are marked on the map with the symbol **P**.

Why rear to the kerb?

Parking rear to the kerb is recommended in busy centres because it slows down traffic and makes it safer for pedestrians.



If you receive a fine

If you receive a parking fine you have 28 days to pay it.

Tip for all-day parking

Consider walking a little further to work to find a car park with no time limit rather than moving your car a number of times during the day. All-day parking areas are marked on the map in **BLUE**. A scale bar showing distances has been marked on the map to show you the distance.



The average person can comfortably walk 400 metres in five minutes.

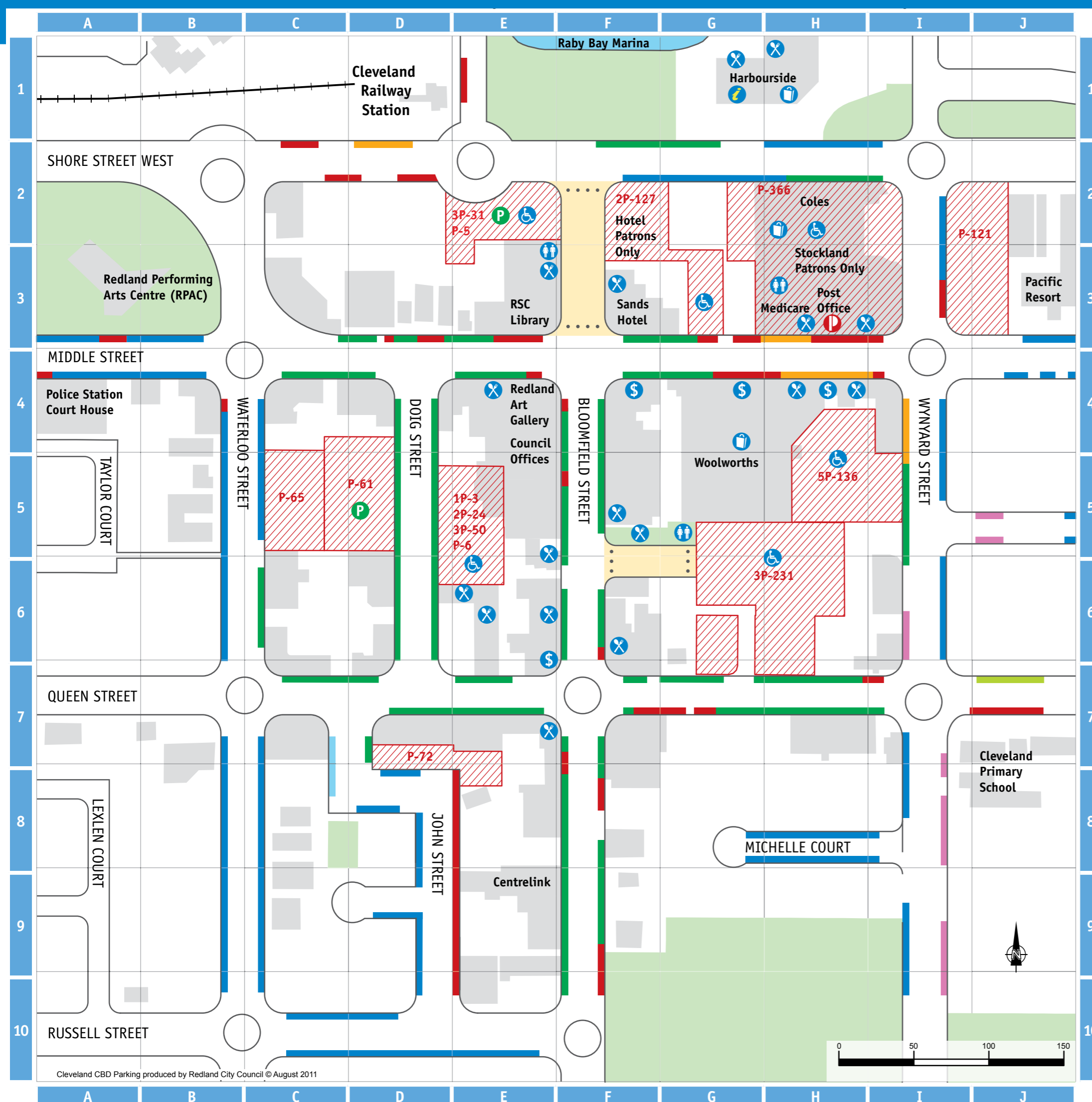
Private off street parking

There are shopping complexes in Cleveland that have designated off street parking for customers. The terms of parking in these areas are usually displayed at the entrances to the car parks.

Important things to remember when parking in Cleveland

- All angle parking is **rear to the kerb**
- Check the signs advising how long you can park
- Don't park in loading zones, no stopping zones and disabled spaces
- Solid, single, yellow line means **NO PARKING**
- Outside the Cleveland CBD, parking time is unlimited unless a sign indicates otherwise.
