Healthy Waterways-Healthy Dolphins: Moreton Bay Dolphin Research Project	This project aims to examine the survival rates, residency patterns and stability of social systems in the resident sub-populations of coastal dolphins in the Southern Moreton Bay Region. Identify areas of critical importance to coastal dolphins in the Southern Moreton Bay region and determine areas of potential conservation concern using a spatial risk assessment. Provide opportunities to enhance public engagement, awareness and action of the Moreton Bay environment through a citizen science program and multi-media interpretive materials. Funds from this grant will be used to complete the field-based surveys associated with this project, promote the citizen surveys associated with the project, promote the citizen program through workshops, presentations and assist in the development of online interpretive materials.	\$9,927.00
CS-162-006	Reef Check Australia	More Moreton Bay Reefs on the Map	This project builds on a 2004 coral baseline for the region, which mapped numerous fringing reef locations in Central Moreton Bay. In 2015, RCA undertook a collaborative project with University of Queensland Biophysical Remote Sensing Centre and Healthy Waterways to inventory reef habitats at eight key reef areas in Moreton Bay. This project will expand coverage to include the remaining near shore areas mapped in 2004, allowing for a comprehensive revised baseline of reefal habitat for the region.	\$10,000.00
