It will consist of short films and a T-shirt/You Tube and Facebook. Grant funds are for a project worker, a film maker, marketing materials and promotional messaging.	\$10,000.00
PS-161-006	Group 61 Inc.	Redlands Community Support Project	An office will be established in the Redlands region for one day per week. A project support consultant will be engaged to build community capacity by contacting local community groups for their support. This will allow the recruitment of volunteers and a referral point. These volunteers will support friends to re-integrate into the community after experiencing mental illness.	\$10,000.00
PS-161-004	Boystown	Skate Safe	Project will work with young people from Boystown's Youth Engagement Program. It will provide a series of skate safety and skill development workshops. It will target young people aged 14-18 years at high risk of disengaging from education, training and employment. The program was self-funded by Boystown in 2015 and to date provided services to 87 young people.	\$10,000.00
PS-161-003	Redlands Community Cancer Support Inc.	Pilot Headsmart Campaign	To reduce brain cancer diagnosis times via a community awareness campaign. The campaign will include a documentary, leaflets, social media and articles and advertisements in local newspapers. After the campaign they intend to provide informed awareness of technology options available e.g. Proton Therapy.	\$10,000.00

PS-161-008	NSI Aboriginal and Islander Housing Cooperative Society Ltd. (Quandamooka Combined Aboriginal Organisations Forum)	ICE-O-LATE-Straddie against drugs	Grant will be used to support the ICE-O-LATE campaign being organised by the Community Wellness Forum under the auspices of the Quandamooka Forum. It aims to increase awareness of the social dysfunction resulting from the drug and the dangers to individual users. Funds will assist in conducting workshops for the community and service providers as well as poster designs and printing.	\$5,500.00
PS-161-002	Parkrun Inc.	Sirromet Parkrun	Project to involve set up and establishment of park run event in Mt Cotton. It caters for 4yrs-104 years of age and all abilities from prams and small children to fast runners. Funding is for IT software, administration and equipment. This includes software for upload times, administration of the website, advertising, promotion, stopwatches, bar code scanners, distance markers and banners.	\$5,000.00
