Q1.	Lodge all forms, documents, plans, reports, supporting information and completed checklists online through eDA

Q2.	Provide the following plans for the proposed development:		
	• site plans		
	floor plans		
	• elevation plans that identify the existing ground level at the face of the building.		
	All plans must be provided in A3 size, identify the reduced levels (RLs) to Australian		
	Height Datum (AHD) and must contain all of the mandatory supporting information identified on DAS Form 1.		



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Q3.	Provide a town planning report for applications for tourist accommodation and/or tourist park that:		
	a) addresses all applicable codes identified in the Redlands Planning Scheme; AND		
	b) demonstrates compliance or otherwise with the specific outcomes in the applicable codes.		
Q4.	Provide a concept landscape plan for applications for tourist accommodation and/or tourist park that identifies:		
	a) landscaping and open space areas provided on the site at ground level; AND		
	b) conceptual species categories, the location of trees, shrubs and groundcover; AND		
	c) the location of any existing vegetation being retained.		
Q5.	Provide an accurate tree plot for applications for tourist accommodation and/or tourist park that shows:		
	a) the location of existing trees in the vicinity of buildings; AND		
	b) the species, height, diameter at breast height and canopy spread; AND		
	c) whether that vegetation is being retained or removed.		
Q6.	Provide a stormwater management plan for applications for tourist accommodation and/or tourist park. The plan must be certified by a Registered Professional Engineer of Queensland and address the Redlands Planning Scheme Stormwater Management Code.		
Q7.	Provide a services location plan for applications for tourist accommodation and/or tourist park that:		
	a) identifies the locations, types and sizes of existing underground infrastructure; AND		
	b) overlays the proposed development to show the distance between building works and existing infrastructure.		
	If you are proposing to relocate underground infrastructure, you must provide a conceptual civil works plan prepared by a Registered Professional Engineer of Queensland that identifies the locations and sizes of the relocated infrastructure.
