This projects main focus is to educate the wider community by going back in time before settlement, drawing attention to Indigenous people's environmental and landscape management practices, identifying the benefits and meaning for Indigenous people that Caring for Country is intricately linked to maintaining Indigenous cultural life, identity, autonomy health and wellbeing. Recognizing and understanding the importance of land management by Indigenous people on Indigenous land. Sharing the need to protect, preserve caring for country for community, our next generation and most importantly MOTHER EARTH.</p> <p>Cultural workshops, storytelling, artifacts displays, weaving, guided tours will be held over the two days.</p>	\$9,920.00
CS-182-008	Positive Change for Marine Life	Tingalpa Creek Marine Debris Monitoring Project	<p>This project aims to mitigate the long-term impacts that marine debris is having on marine ecosystems in the Redland region through 12 kayak-based surveys (first 6-months). The surveys will monitor and record debris, whilst identifying litter hotspots across the 11.5km length of the creek.</p> <p>Post-surveys, a Marine Debris Report Card will be produced based on our findings and we will run 4 educational and awareness events, as well as two water-based community clean ups to educate users on the importance of stopping marine debris at its source (next 6 months). The Report Card, educational programs and public cleans will be used as a tool to inform and engage recreational users, businesses, tourists and the broader community to the impacts of debris and how they can act as stewards in protecting their marine environment. These components will be funded and supported by our organisation and partners and we hope to continue our work beyond the scope of this grant.</p>	\$9,999.50
