(Making of Local Law) Website Notice (No. 1) 2018

#### **Title**

1. This notice may be cited as Redland City Council (Making of Local Law) Website Notice (No.1) 2018.

#### **Making of local law**

2. Redland City Council (the "Council") has, by resolution dated 23 May 2018, made *Interim Local Law No. 1 (Waste Management) 2018* (the "local law").

#### **Commencement**

3. The *Interim Local Law No. 1 (Waste Management) 2018* and local law amendments below commence on 1 July 2018.

#### **Expiry**

4. The *Interim Local Law No. 1 (Waste Management) 2018* expires on 31 December 2018.

#### **Purpose and general effect**

5. The purpose and general effect of the local law is to protect the City's public health, safety and amenity related to waste management by –
  - a) regulating the storage, servicing and removal of waste;
  - b) regulating the disposal of waste at Councils waste management facilities;
  - c) ensuring and act or omission does not result in human injury, property damage or environmental harm; and
  - d) designating general waste and green waste collection areas in the City.

#### **Local Law Amendments**

6. Schedule 1 Item 2 (g) of *Subordinate Local Law No. 4 (Local Government Controlled Areas, Facilities and Roads) 2015* has been repealed to delete duplicate provisions within *Interim Local Law No. 1 (Waste Management) 2018*.
7. Redland City Council has, by resolution dated 23 May 2018, resolved to amend *Subordinate Local Law 5 (Parking) 2015* to increase the penalty unit value of 0.7 be increased to 1 penalty unit.

#### **Inspection**

8. From 1 July 2018 copies of the local law and amendments may be –
  - a) Inspected and purchased at Council's Customer Service Centres; and
  - b) Viewed by the public on the website of the Department of Local Government, Racing and Multicultural Affairs.
