

Interim Vegetation Order

Interim vegetation protection orders can be made under Section 14 of Local Law No. 6 'Protection of Vegetation'.

To do this, information must be gathered which identifies the person making the application, the vegetation to be protected, its whereabouts and the grounds on which the VPO is to be made. The vegetation may be a single tree or a group of trees.

Grounds for Protection of the Vegetation

The grounds on which a vegetation protection order is made must be stated in the Vegetation Protection Order (VPO). The grounds must be consistent with the objects of Local Law No.6 Protection of Vegetation. In particular, the Vegetation Protection Order must protect significant vegetation. Whether the vegetation is significant will be determined by an assessment process undertaken by Council.
