### **Before Completing This Form**

If your shipping container or railway carriage will be fixed to the ground (e.g. placed on footings) or forms part of another structure (e.g. has an awning or deck attached), it is defined as a building structure under the *Building Act 1975*.

If the object is defined as a building structure, the Subordinate Local Law 1.19 will <u>not</u> apply – <u>do not</u> complete this application.

If a building approval has been issued for a dwelling and you're a placing a shipping container, railway carriage or other object for the duration of the house build, an application is not required under subordinate Local Law 1.19 – however, you may need to consult with your building certifier.

### **Additional Approvals**

In addition, a building approval will be required if the object is defined as a building structure. Please contact your local Private Building Certifier for further information.

You may also need plumbing approval for any fixtures within the building. Please contact Council's Plumbing Services team if you require any further information.

## **Approval Period Definitions**

<u>Temporary Approval:</u> Council defines temporary as no more than a term of 3 months.

<u>Permanent Approval:</u> Council defines permanent as a term greater than 3 months.

### **Application Information**

### Site Plan:

- Minimum size of plans to be A4 and to be clear, legible and to scale – no graph paper or pencil.
- All boundary length measurements of property, including north point
- All road frontages
- Location of all existing buildings on site, including the width of building frontage
- Indicate setback of outer most projection of shipping container, railway carriage or other object to front and/or side boundary of property

### **Design Details:**

- Dimensions of each shipping container, railway carriage or other object including max. height above natural ground level
- Gross area (m²) of shipping container, railway carriage or other object

### **Important Information**

Once the shipping container, railway carriage or other object has Local Law approval, it is the Applicant's responsibility to repair, repaint or renovate the object when issued with a written notice from the Local Government.

Council conducts regular audits to ensure approved objects comply with the conditions of the approval.

Applicants that fail to comply with the conditions of an approval may be subject to a penalty infringement notice.
