

003-Bud Lighting

Bud Lighting Maintenance Checklist

Information:

This checklist must be lodged with Tree Management Alterations - Bud Lighting on Council Street Trees Application (001-Bud Lighting). Additionally, Application Requirements (002-Bud Lighting) will be required at lodgement. The quality of information that you provide at lodgement stage will assist with timely assessment.

Redland City council will undertake regular audits to ensure compliance with bud lighting permits including maintenance schedule records. It is the responsibility of the permit holder to complete the following checklist for the life of the permit.

Inspections:

Weekly

- □ Check for faulty bud lights and dangling cables
- Check health and integrity of tree including broken branches
- Ensure bud lights do not cause damage to tree growth and natural shape

Annually

□ Maintain tree health and appearance by removing loose bark that may have collected under lighting strings and attachments. Ensure public safety, amenity and tree protection is maintained.

<u>Ongoing</u>

- □ Contact Council about broken branches or concerns about the condition of street trees.
- □ Renewal of permitted bud lighting must be submitted 6 months prior to the currency period: permits are not transferrale and are only valid for the precinct on the permit and for the applicant of the permit
- □ When severe weather causes street tree damage, Council will disengage the lights at the on/off switch and make the situation safe for the public. However, permit holders are responsible for reinstating and fixing any damaged lighting.
- □ Undertake all maintenance in accordance with work safe standards.

NOTE: Costs incurred by Council in making safe a public safety hazard associated with non-compliant bud lighting can be recovered from the permit holder
