

Community Grants

What categories are available?

Community Grants Program

- **Organisation Support** – Grants of up to \$3,000 to support community organisations improve planning, governance and management practices on Redlands Coast.
- **Project Support** – Grants of up to \$10,000 to support organisations providing specific one-off projects that deliver positive outcomes on Redlands Coast.
- **Conservation Grants** – Grants of up to \$10,000 to assist individuals or organisations for specific projects that will provide positive outcomes for the environment and wildlife on Redlands Coast.

Who can apply?

To be eligible to apply, applicants must:

- be a not-for-profit, incorporated organisation or be auspiced by a not-for-profit, incorporated organisation
- hold current public liability insurance
- be operating and financially viable
- have no outstanding acquittals or debts with Council.

What projects are eligible?

Eligible projects must:

- be conducted in the Redland City Council (RCC) area
- align to one or more of the program objectives
- align to one or more of Council's 2018–2023 Corporate Plan objectives.

Application tips

- Plan your project.
- Ensure you read the program guidelines.
- Consult with Council's grants team.
- Be realistic – only ask for what you need.
- Ensure you attach all your supporting documentation.

All applicants must register and apply online via *Smarty Grants*. Links to application forms will be available when the funding round opens.
