Roadside stall – Acceptable Outcomes

<input type="checkbox"/>	A01.1 Produce or goods sold are grown, made or produced on the land on which the roadside stall is erected.
<input type="checkbox"/>	A02.1 The roadside stall does not exceed 40m ² in gross floor area.
<input type="checkbox"/>	A02.2 There is only one (1) roadside stall on each lot.
<input type="checkbox"/>	A02.3 The opening hours of the roadside stall are limited to between 7am to 6pm.
<input type="checkbox"/>	A02.4 Space to accommodate four (4) customer vehicles is provided.
