Community Grants

What categories are available?

Community Grants Program 2021-2022

- **Organisation Support** – up to \$3,000 to help organisations improve planning, governance and management practices.
- **Project Support** – up to \$10,000 to help organisations with one-off projects, events or activities that will benefit the community.
- **Conservation Grant** – up to \$10,000 to help organisations or individuals with conservation projects that will benefit the environment and wildlife.
- **Capital Infrastructure** – to help organisations to build, renovate or refurbish community facilities.
Small Capital – up to \$10,000. Applicants are required to make a 20% cash contribution to the project.
Major Capital – up to \$50,000. Applicants are required to make a 50% cash contribution to the project.

Who can apply?

To be eligible to apply, applicants must:

- Be a not-for-profit, incorporated organisation; or be auspiced by a not-for-profit, incorporated organisation.
- Hold current public liability insurance.
- Be operating and financially viable.
- Have no outstanding acquittals or debts with Council.

What projects are eligible?

Eligible projects must:

- Be conducted in the Redland City Council local government area.
- Align to one or more of the Program Objectives.

- Align to one or more of the Strategic Goals in Council's *Our Future Redlands – a Corporate Plan to 2026 and Beyond*.

Application tips

- Plan your project.
- Ensure you read the program guidelines.
- Consult with Council's community grants team.
- Be realistic – only ask for what you need.
- Ensure you attach all supporting documentation.

How can I apply?

All applicants must register and apply online via *Smarty Grants*. Links to application forms will be available when the funding rounds open.
