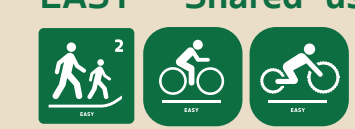

DIFFICULT — Single-use (downhill) trails

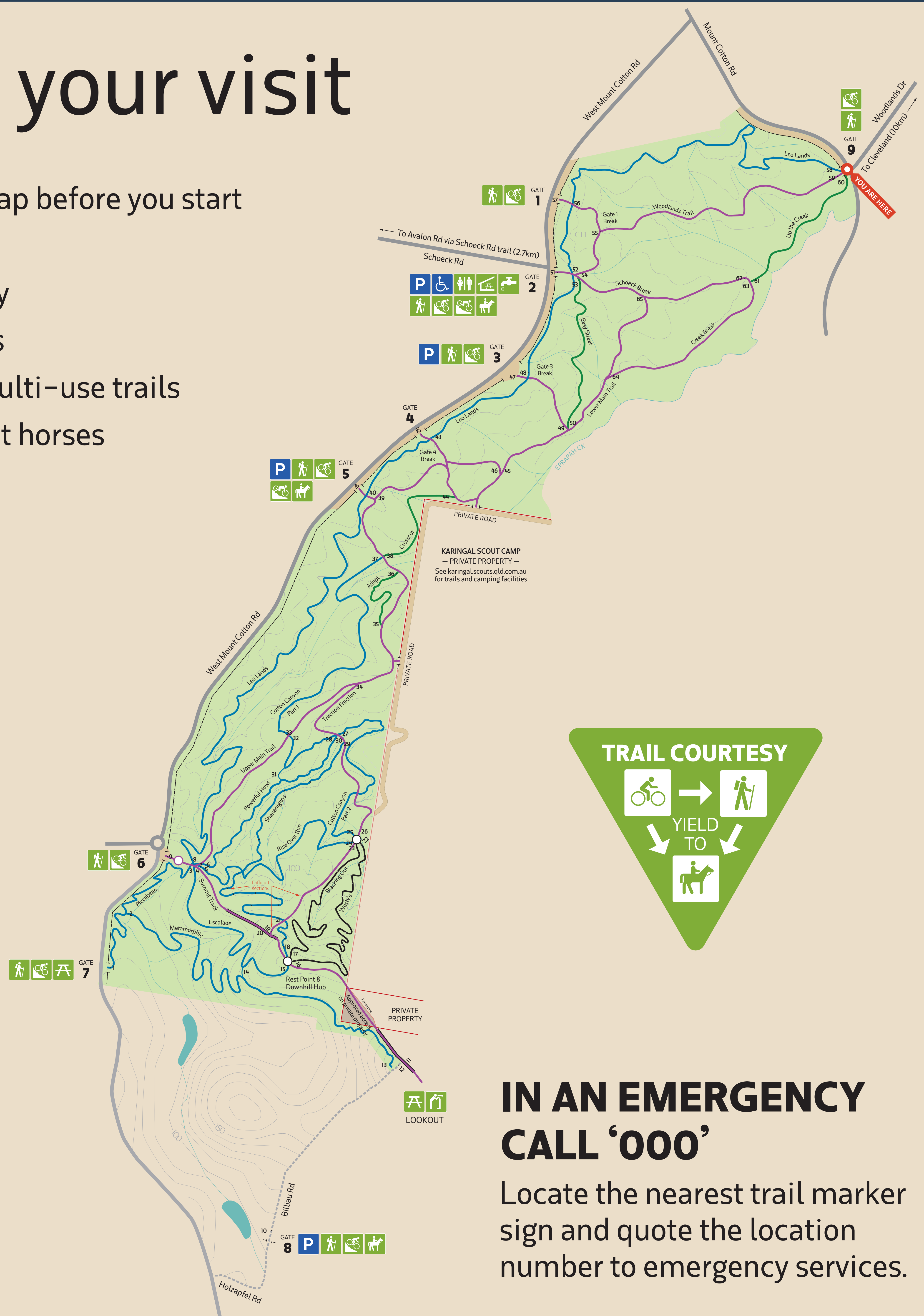

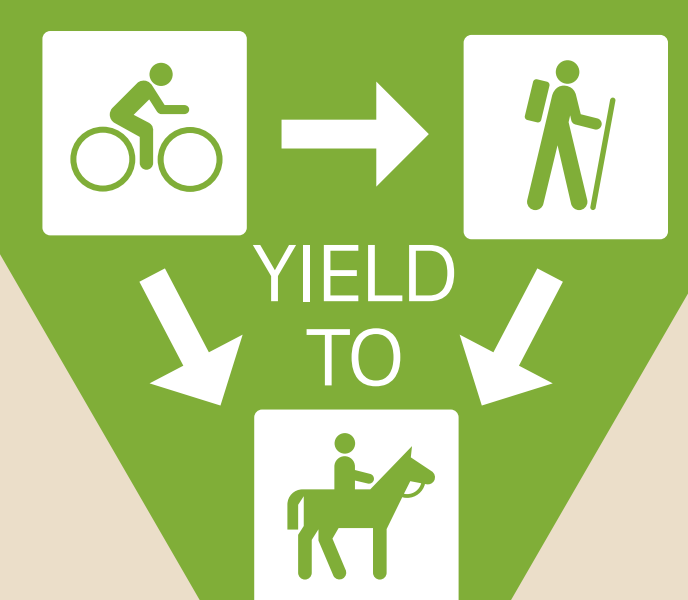
