Redland City has just closed a chapter in the history of its existence with the loss of our Redland water business. I encourage all Redlands residents to be informed and closely question decisions made by all levels of government as these decisions will impact your future. We must strive to ensure responsible, accountable governance that reflects the needs and expectations of a Redlands working together.

ALLCONNEX – new water distributor and retailer

On 1 July, Redland Water officially ceased to exist. Allconnex Water began operations and will provide the following services to the residents of the Redlands, Gold Coast and Logan areas:

- buying water from the state government-owned SEQ Water Grid Manager and delivering it to residents and businesses
- · collecting, treating and disposing of sewage
- managing and maintaining infrastructure and assets, including water supply mains and sewer networks
- operating water and sewage pumping stations
- providing a specialised recycled water service to a number of businesses
- managing accounts for household and commercial water and sewerage services and trade waste disposal.

Though Redland City Council remains one of the three shareholders of Allconnex, any control of pricing or delivery of future infrastructure will be determined by Allconnex's recently appointed Board. Our equity in this new business has not yet been finalised and an independent arbitrator has been appointed by the state government. Many residents over the last three years, have continued to oppose and question the loss of our water, and I thank them for their efforts.
