Budget 06/07

On June 22, Council adopted its budget for the following financial year. Below are some of the projects that have now been secured for Division 9.

- Valentine Park Safety Lighting \$86,000
- Capalaba Regional Park Stage Three \$750,000
- Redland's Youth Plaza John Fredericks Park \$800,000
- Coolnwynpin Creek Energy Dissipater \$160,000
- Capalaba Waste Water Treatment Plant Odour Treatment \$500,000
- Pittwin Road South Footpath \$22,000
- Mount Cotton Road/School Road Intersection Traffic Signals \$235,000

Community Consultations

There are some significant consultations taking place in the Redlands and Capalaba in the near future. This is your opportunity to make sure your opinions and concerns are noted and addressed. Please find the time to give your input. Some of these issues may affect you directly or indirectly. Now is the time to be heard.

Animal Management Laws

If you own a dog, a cat, horse or any other animal, this law will affect you. Make sure your voice is heard! This proposal includes changes to the Local Law 2 and its subordinate law such as cat identification and the confinement of dogs at night on properties greater than 2000m^2 in Koala Management Areas. If you oppose or support this – please let it be known. The Local Government Act requires all submissions to be in writing. All submissions will be considered and reported to the Council based on community feedback. The Council will then consider these submissions and make a final decision on the new law. John Frederick Park Master Plan

Eastern Busway
