Upcoming projects

Moreton Bay Cycleway, Ormiston

This cycle and walkway will connect the northern part of Ormiston with Wellington Point (Hilliards Creek Crossing) as part of the bigger Moreton Bay Cycleway project (50% funded by the state government).

\$2,237,500

Burnett Street, Wellington Point

Burnett Street will receive new underground drainage, kerb and channel and widening from the Main Road/Edith Street intersection to Station Street.

Starkey Street, Wellington Point

A new culvert crossing will link to the existing pathway on Duncan Street.

\$84,000

Pathway and boardwalk linkages to Wellington Point Village Green

This year will see the design phase of a pathway and boardwalk linking the Village Green to Wetlands Link Park, Wellington Point.

Bicycle parking on Main Road, Wellington Point Village - construction
