Hello just a short note to give you an update on what is happening around the Division.

Park Upgrades and Maintenance

The trial on the Hanover Drive dog off-leash area was completed and the fencing has now been upgraded to permanent status. Seating and a water fountain have been added to complete the works. Extensive tree maintenance has occurred in the O'Gorman Street Park to remove unsafe older gums which will be replaced by newly planted trees. It was sad to see these big fellows go as some were at least 150 years old, but the safety of the park users, especially near the playground equipment, was a prime concern.

Council's Action Request System

Residents approach me from time to time requesting minor maintenance works to be done which includes trees, potholes and the like. I thought it maybe a good time to explain the best ways to advise Council about attending to these matters. Most action requests are commenced within a few days depending on the urgency of the matter. Issues like broken glass in sand areas are addressed immediately. I strongly advise when making contact that you ask for an Action Request Number, so if your item has not been fixed in a reasonable amount of time, staff or myself can track the action, or lack of it, easily.

Finucane Road - Hilliards Creek to Delancey Street

Finally, after much negotiation between Main Roads and Council officers the above median strip section of road has been paved. The section between Hilliards Creek and Dawson Road is expected to be completed in the 2006/07 budget. Other smaller sections towards Capalaba will be completed in future vears.
