

**Re: Implementation of 40 kph AREA Speed limit on Karragarra Island**

In December 2013 Redland City Council (RCC) responded to a request by Councillor Mark Edwards on behalf of the Karragarra Island community in passing a resolution to authorise Council officers to investigate and seek all the necessary approvals for the implementation of a 40km/h speed limit on all the public roads on Karragarra Island.

The Speed Management Committee (SMC) at its meeting on 26th March, 2014 granted formal approval to RCC for reduced speed limits 40km/h speed limit on all the public roads on Karragarra Island with a 20km/h speed limit on The Esplanade, between Bertram Road and swimming area to improve safety following a request by residents.

Although the potential use of golf buggies was not raised at the SMC meeting, having regard for the view of the representations from the local community on the island, Council would give in-principle support for golf buggies to be driven on local roads on the island.

I understand that Queensland Transport and Queensland Police Service have jurisdiction and authority to determine or proclaim the eligibility of a vehicle for registration or conditional registration for use on public roads. Council will fully support the decisions of your department.
