

Public Transport in Cleveland

Buses and trains from urban areas in Redland City to Cleveland provide convenient ways for workers to get to and from work without having to drive into the Cleveland central business district (CBD) and park.

Translink is also introducing new ways to make it easier to pay your train and bus fares. Contactless payment, e.g. by PayWave or smartphone (Apple Pay or Google Pay), is being rolled out across the network.

Trains

If you live near a train station on the Cleveland line or one of its extensions, you can easily get to the Cleveland CBD by train.

Cleveland Station is just 250 metres from the Cleveland Library and a 300-metre walk to Middle Street shops.

Parking at train stations is free. And if you want to ride a bike or e-scooter to the station, bike racks and lockers are available and can be booked online. See [‘Travelling with your bike’](#) on the Queensland Rail website.

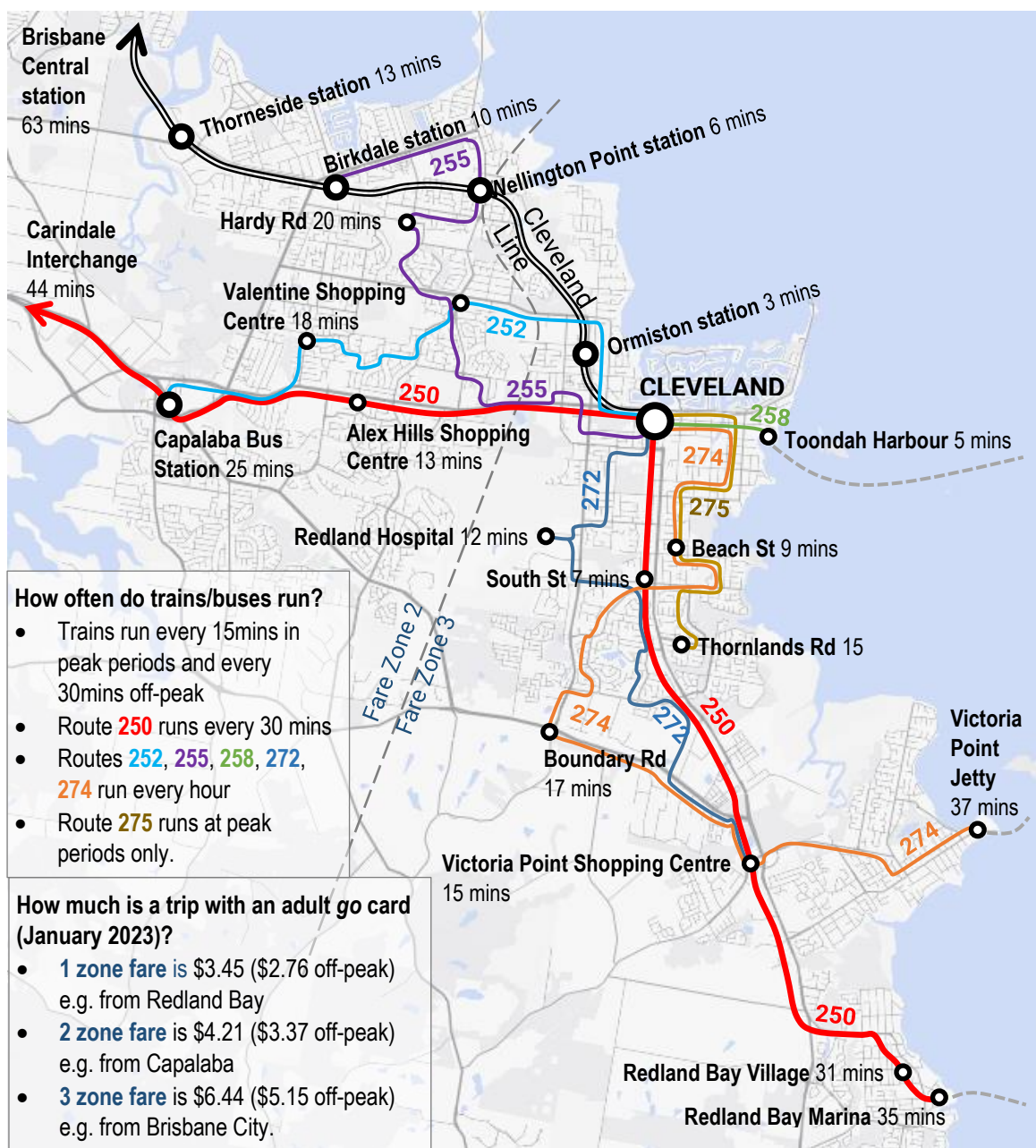

Buses

The map below shows where you can catch a direct bus to Cleveland and the main routes and destinations in Redland City. The Middle Street bus stop at Cleveland Central Shopping Centre is only 100 metres from Council's library and administration buildings.

Use the Translink app to see when buses and trains are due in real-time rather than just the timetable.
