#### **Title**

#### **Making of Subordinate local law**

2. Redland City Council (the "Council") has, by resolution dated 15 March 2023, made *Amending Subordinate Local Law No. 6 (Subordinate Local Law No. 1.2 (Commercial use of Local Government Controlled Areas and Roads) 2015) 2023* (the "amending local law").

#### **Subordinate local law being amended**

3. *Amending Subordinate Local Law No. 6 (Subordinate Local Law No. 1.2 (Commercial Use of Local Government Controlled Areas and Roads) 2015) 2023* amends *Subordinate Local Law No. 1.2 (Commercial Use of Local Government Controlled Areas and Roads) 2015*.

#### **Commencement**

4. *Amending Subordinate Local Law No. 6 (Subordinate Local Law No. 1.2 (Commercial Use of Local Government Controlled Areas and Roads) 2015) 2023* and the subordinate local law being amended commence on 24 March, 2023.

#### **Local Law Amendments**

5. The amendments to *Subordinate Local Law No. 1.2 (Commercial Use of Local Government Controlled Areas and Roads) 2015* refined the definition of footpath dining, removing the requirement for the adjacent land occupier's consent for a footpath dining applications, updated the public liability requirements and aligned the conditions with current approval practice.
