Participant Application Terms and Conditions

Please read the following conditions and accept them on the online EOI form <u>before</u> submitting your expression of interest to participate in this trade delegation.

1. Acknowledgements:

- a) As a part of the assessment process, Council may undertake detailed company searches and background checks (e.g., ASIC search).
- b) If selected, participants will be willing to complete a short outcomes summary following the trip, listing meetings and outcomes achieved or in process.
- c) Participant's contact details may be shared with the delegates travelling on the trade delegation and with relevant government agencies such as Trade & Investment Queensland and Austrade.
- d) Participant's business name, logo and website may be used on Redland City Council's communications and promotional material to promote my business.
- 2. No legal relationship:
 - a) Nothing in the terms and conditions shall imply the creation of any legal relationship between the participant and Redland City Council.
 - b) Attendance at the Tamil Nadu Global Investors Meet (TNGIM), Vibrant Gujarat Global Summit (VGGS) and other pre/post event activities are done so at the participant's own risk and cost. Costs include international and domestic airfares, transfers, accommodation, insurance and other costs such as meals, hospitality, personal expenses, communications (mobile / internet), tips and gratuities etc.
