The following options are available for 28 days after the date of issue of the notice.

Option 1 – Pay in full (all offences)

If your full payment is received within 28 days, this infringement will be finalised and no further enforcement action will be taken against you.

Payment options include:

- By phone: Call Council on 07 3829 8999 Monday to Friday between 8.30am and 4.30pm to make payment.
- Online: Payment at redland.qld.gov.au/infringements
- By mail: Send a cheque or money order to Redland City Council, PO Box 21 Cleveland QLD 4163. Please forward this notice with your payment. Cheques and money orders should be made payable to Redland City Council.
- In person: Payment by cash, credit card, cheque or money order may be made at one of our Customer Service Centres

Payment of this notice removes the option to have the matter decided by a Magistrates Court.

OR

Option 2 – Apply to pay by instalments (offences of \$200 or over)

If this notice has a fine of \$200 or more, you may apply to pay by instalments of \$60 per month.

If your application is received within 28 days, and you make all monthly payments, this infringement will be finalised and no further prosecution or enforcement action will be taken against you.

To apply, please contact Council on one of the options provided at the bottom of this notice. You are required to provide your full name, address and identification details as well as an initial payment of \$60.

After making this application, an instalment plan will be sent to you by the State Penalties Enforcement Registry (SPER). Remaining instalments are required to be paid to SPER in any way acceptable by the agency. Failure to comply with the instalment plan will result in enforcement by SPER and additional fees may be payable. Election to pay this notice by instalments removes the option to have the matter decided by court.

OR

Option 3 – Elect to have a Court hearing (all offences)

You have the right to elect to have this matter dealt with by a Court.

To do this, visit redland.qld.gov.au/infringements to complete a court election request or download and complete the Infringement Court Election form and forward to Council notifying us of your request within 28 days from the date of this notice.

Before deciding to have the matter dealt with by the Court, please consider that the Court has the power to award costs against you if you are unsuccessful. The costs could include an increased infringement amount, and any costs incurred by Council. If you do not appear on the date set for the hearing, the offence may be heard in your absence.

OR

Option 4 – Lodge a Statutory Declaration (vehicle related offences)

If you were served with this notice as the owner of an offending vehicle, you are taken to have committed the offence. However, your liability may be removed by providing by providing a Statutory Declaration nomination form stating that the vehicle:

- Was being used illegally;
- Was being used by another person (nominated by you);
- Was being used by another person (but unable to be identified);
- Had been sold or otherwise disposed of.

If your Statutory Declaration Nomination Form is received within 28 days and the actual offender can be identified, an Infringement Notice will be sent to the nominated party. If the actual offender cannot be identified, enforcement of this notice against you may be continued in accordance with the *State Penalties Enforcement Act 1999*.

Your Statutory Declaration may be made by obtaining a form from Council's website, making the declaration in the presence of a Justice of the Peace or Commissioner for Declarations and returning the declaration to one of the addresses shown below.

After an initial payment of \$60, Infringements will be referred to the State Penalties Enforcement Registry for an instalment plan. Contact SPER on 1300 365 635

OPTION 3: Election for court hearing

You have the right to elect to have this matter dealt with by a court.

To do this, submit written documentation to Council notifying us of your request within 28 days from the date of this notice (see contact details in Option 1). Please provide your name, address and Infringement Notice details. Before deciding to have the matter dealt with by the court, please consider that the court has the power to award costs against you if you are unsuccessful. The costs could include a fine imposed by the magistrate, and any costs incurred by Council.

OPTION 4: For vehicle offences only

If you are the registered vehicle owner you are considered responsible for the offence. If you were not in charge of the vehicle at the time of offence you have the option to submit a statutory declaration to Council nominating the responsible person (see contact details in Option 1). Please provide the name and address of the person (if known) within 28 days from the date of this notice. A template is available on Council's website.

OPTION 5: Lodge an appeal

If you have received an infringement notice but believe there are extenuating circumstances that need to be considered, you can make an appeal to have the infringement reviewed.

Appeals will only be considered if lodged by the registered owner of the vehicle at the time of the offence.

To do this, submit Infringement Appeal form found on Council's website with your name, address, and Infringement Notice details within 28 days from the date of this notice and email to Council at rcc@redland.qld.gov.au

Should you choose to take no action this matter may be referred to the State Penalties Enforcement Registry (SPER) or lodged with a Magistrates Court. Additional costs may be incurred in both instances.

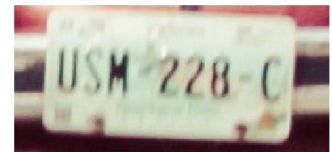

Infringement Notice

This Infringement Notice has been issued to you as your vehicle has been observed committing an alleged parking offence.

In accordance with Section 14 of the *State Penalties Enforcement Act 1999* which states that if the Infringement Notice involves a vehicle it may be served under Section 14 of the *State Penalties Enforcement Act 1999* where by, a parking notice may be served by post, at the address of the owner in the register of vehicles kept under a registration Act.

To avoid additional fees, please make payment or consider alternative options as outlined on the front page of this notice by the due date.



Notice of Intention to File a Default Certificate

If you fail to pay the outstanding amount, or undertake another listed option to finalise this matter, a final Notice of Intention to File a Default Certificate will be issued and additional fees will be incurred.

If no action is taken to finalise this matter by the due date on this notice, this matter will be lodged with the State Penalties Enforcement Registry (SPER) for enforcement.



SPER Enforcement

If the matter is lodged with the State Penalties Enforcement Registry (SPER), an enforcement order will be issued, and this will include additional fees being incurred.
