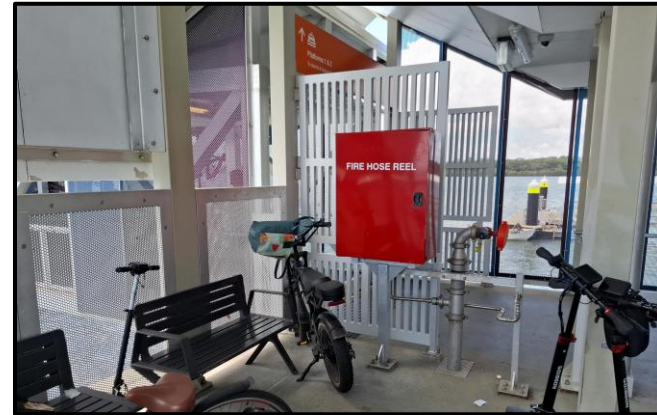

Background

- Personal Mobility Devices (PMD) are essential for many SMBI residents due to limited transport options and long distances to key services.
- Incorrect PMD parking creates safety risks, blocks access paths and reduces accessibility at ferry terminals.
- Improved design, visibility and usability of PMD storage supports safer, more accessible ferry terminals.

Karragarra – location of facilities

Additional parking is available near the ferry terminal with capacity for up to 20 bikes.



Macleay – location of facilities

Parking available for 28 bikes and e-scooters.

Additional parking bays for two (2) mobility devices.

Additional parking for four (4) bikes and e-scooters.

Additional parking bays for three (3) mobility devices.



Lamb – location of facilities

Additional parking available for 15 bikes and e-scooters.

Additional parking bays for three (3) mobility devices.



Russell – location of facilities

Additional parking available for 34 bikes and e-scooters.

Additional parking bays for two (2) mobility devices.

Additional parking for four (4) bikes and e-scooters.
