The event attracts a strong audience of outdoor and adventure enthusiasts seeking to explore and purchase products including caravans, boats, vehicles, outdoor gear, and holiday offerings. Family-friendly entertainment and complimentary entry to the Redland Museum enhance the visitor experience, making the Expo both a commercial success and an engaging, all-ages community event.	\$20,000

A fixture on Australia’s cultural calendar since 2000, the festival relocated to Cleveland in 2016 and now attracts a national and international audience to Redlands Coast for a distinctive, high-quality experience. Live music remains central to GreazeFest, showcasing genres such as rockabilly and rhythm’n’blues that continue to thrive through dedicated musicians and audiences. The festival offers a diverse and inclusive program, featuring hot rod displays, cultural markets, an art show supporting the RSPCA, youth-focused Unplugged Sessions, dance workshops, quality food vendors, and a village green overlooking the main stage. As one of Australia’s longest-running and most vibrant festivals, GreazeFest delivers ongoing cultural, community, and economic benefits to a broad audience.	\$35,000

In 2025, it was named the ‘Hero’ activity of Redlands Adventure Week. The event attracts athletes and visitors from across Australia, generating strong tourism outcomes, with over 4,500 attendees and an estimated \$2.2 million in economic impact. Delivered in partnership with the Quandamooka Yoolooburrabee Aboriginal Corporation, the Straddie Salute incorporates cultural elements and continues to strengthen the region’s reputation for major outdoor events.	\$35,000
