

Statutory Declaration – Nomination Oaths Act 1867

If you were NOT in control of the vehicle at the time the offence was committed, you must NOT pay this infringement notice. Instead, complete the statutory declaration below and return it within 28 days from the date of the notice. Upon receipt, a new infringement notice will be issued to the individual you nominate as having been in control of the vehicle at the relevant time.

1. Person in charge includes the person driving, or responsible for the vehicle, or the new owner of the vehicle.
2. When this notice is served on the registered owner, the person is taken to have committed the offence even though the person driving may have been someone else. The registered owner may transfer liability to the person in charge of the vehicle by correctly completing the above Statutory Declaration and returning it within 28 days of the notice date.
3. This declaration must be **witnessed** by a Justice of the Peace, Commissioner of Declarations, lawyer, notary public or another person authorised to administer an oath under the Oaths Act 1867.
4. Pursuant to Sections 19(3) and 20(3) of the State Penalties Enforcement Act 1999, a copy of this declaration will be given to the nominated user of the vehicle, if required. **Information Privacy Act 2009** - Redland City Council is collecting your personal information in order to process this statutory declaration. The information will only be used by authorised Council Officers for the purpose of ensuring our records are accurate and carrying out related Council functions with respect to this parking infringement. Your information will not be given to any other person or agency unless you have given us permission or we are required by law to do so.
